Half Moon Bay Again Sharp In Soquel Meet

High school runners from as far away as Fresno and Sacramento congregated Saturday morning at Soquel High School for the eighth running of the Soquel Cross-Country Invitational Meet.

Half Moon Bay - as it did one week ago in the Aptos Invitational - turned in one of the more team impressive performances of the day. The Cougars, a small school team, prevailed in both the boys and girls varsity compeition as well as the sophomore boys division.

Mira Loma nabbed both the combined championship-large school boys varsity class and the junior varsity division. The small school, large school split is 1,680 enrollment.

David Coulmon of San Mateo covered the boys' 2.7-mile course in 13:20 for the day's top time and a first place individual finish in the combined championship-large school varsity race. Aptos' Tim Gruber sprinted across the line fourth in 13:29 and Soquel's Rick Island paced his team to fifth with a 13:49 eighth place time.

Aptos' Nancy Huyck, who last week ran second on her own course to Pacific Grove's Ann Trason, took second once again to Trason. Huyck concluded the 2.1-mile journey in 12:17, more than one-half minute behind Trason who clocked in at 11:39. Santa Cruz' Terry Schneider finished sixth at 12:28, while Soquel netted a fifth in team competition with 114 points.

San Lorenzo Valley's frosh-soph girls achieved the most impressive local overall performance with a second place in team comptition, and an individual first from Deena Pearson and a fourth from Sue Kessy. The Valley took runner-up to Redwood, 43-54, and Pearson, a sophomore who finished seventh last year, checked in two seconds ahead of her nearest challenger. 13:12 to 13:14. Kessy was just 17 seconds off the pace set by Pearson, finishing at 13:29 for fourth

Soquel, paced by Kristy Jacobson's 13:52 ninth place, nailed down a team fifth with 81 points in frosh-soph girls action. Santa Cruz' Allison Sanford came home two seconds behind Jacobson for 10th, and Aptos' Debbie Crandall checked in 14-flat for 12th.

Soquel High, on the strength of Bob Bauld and Nevin Hougardy, totaled 62 points in the junior varsity competition for runner-up honors to Mira Loma's 30 points. Bauld finished eighth in 15:35 and Hougardy just three seconds behind him in 10th with a 15:38 clocking. Fellow Knight Greg Bica took fifth in the large school frosh race with a time of

San Lorenzo Valley's frosh boys - not to be outdone to a great degree by its girls posted a fifth place teamwise with 115 points, thanks to the solid performances by Chris Manson and Jeff Smith. Manson traveled to a fourth place finish with a 15:17 timing while Smith crossed the line 10th in

Aptos' John Kane concluded 14th, 22 seconds behind Smith at 16:23. Harbor, although not placing anyone in the top 10. received good balance overall to garner eighth with 192 points.

Soquel High cross country coach Ken Thomas called the event a "very successful" one, and estimated that about 900 boys and girls participated in the meet which attracted 44 schools from throughout northern and central California.
