


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

SEEDED RACES

Qualification for the seeded races is determined by previous best times. Runners who have run faster than the following times will run the SEEDED RACE: Girls—20:00 for 3 miles or 20:40 for 5K; Boys—15:30 for 3 miles or 16:10 for 5K. The top eight finishers in each of the seeded races qualify for the Foot Locker National Finals in Lake Buena Vista, Florida on December 13, 1997.

FRESHMAN, SOPHOMORE, JUNIOR AND SENIOR RACES

All runners who do not qualify for the seeded races will compete in the appropriate race based on his/her year in school. In the interest of competition and safety, the sophomore, junior and senior boys races will be divided according to randomly assigned race numbers.

COACH/PARENT RACE

THIS IS NOT AN "OPEN" RACE, but is limited to coaches and parents of 1997 Western Regional high school competitors only. Age divisions (men and women): 29 & under, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60 and over. Entry fee, entry instructions and check-in information is the same as for high school competitors. Use entry form at right.

INDIVIDUAL MEDALS

The top twenty-four finishers in races #2 through #14 are awarded medals. Medals will also be awarded to the top 3 men and 3 women per division in the Coach/Parent Race—#1.

STATE TEAM AWARDS

The top five individual male and top five individual female finishers from every state constitute that state's "team." Each individual on the top five state teams is awarded a medal. All races will be considered in figuring the top times from each state. Scoring is figured on a cumulative time basis. There is no club scoring.
