Motion: Add meet director duties for SCVAL #2 (Crystal Preview) to by-laws. Meet director will be the same for SCVAL #2 & Championship meet.

Moved by Saratoga and seconded by Santa Clara. All schools in support, motion carried. Rotating responsibilities for meet director for SCVAL #2 & SCVAL Championships will follow the list in SCVAL by-laws Section 6.

Motion: Move Monta Vista to bottom of rotating responsibilities list and skip over Paly/Los Altos as long as they continue to host SCVAL #1 & 3.

Moved by Lynbrook, seconded by Santa Clara. All schools in support, motion carried.

Motion: Change by-laws so coaches can vote at pre-season meeting on whether we charge a gate fee at SCVAL Championships or if schools will pay the meet fee. If we vote to have gate fees we would follow rotating responsibilities for gate/ticket sellers as listed in by-laws.

Moved by Santa Clara, seconded by Los Altos. All schools in support, motion carried.

Other notes

- Kirk has offered to order medals, t-shirts, bibs now if we can all pay in advance. Kirk could do these three things for a little less than \$200 per school, and have this all shipped to the person who is taking over next year. Or we pass these jobs to the new meet director. Kirk will discuss with 2023 meet directors.
- Reminder of 50% rule for individuals competing at CCS. Also reminder that teams qualify to CCS if they are in the top half of the <u>teams</u> that <u>start</u> the race. So everyone needs to try to get 5 on the line so that 4 teams can qualify automatically.
- 5. Vote for the Sportsmanship Team award and Coach of the Year award for each division.
