

North Coast Section Cross --CC-> Rankings

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This is the last episode of the 1998 season. The races have been run the accolades gathered and the triumphant and near-triumphant have returned home to rest, log up miles, and recharge the batteries for the upcoming track season. By all accounts, the NCS forces did very well at the State Meet, and we should all be rightfully proud of our contribution to California running, where the best prep runners in the country come from.

State Meet:

In line with tradition, the strongest NCS showing was in the girls races, particularly the Division III contest. NCS girls took top honors in D-III with Sara Bei of Montgomery (17:22) and D-V with Kira Morser of University (18:20). There were a multitude of top 10 runners as well: Trina Cox, Santa Rosa (I-2, 17:48); Katie Hotchkiss, Mission San Jose (I-9, 18:31); Stephanie Ksenzulak, Liberty (III-3, 18:12); Jenny Aldridge, Maria Carillo (III-7, 18:46); Sarah Bashel, Montgomery (III-9, 18:46); Amy Loper-Riley, Alhambra (IV-3, 18:57); Tiffany Vickers, Del Norte (IV-6, 19:07); Laurel Weil, El Molino (IV-8, 19:10); Jessica Neu, Alhambra (IV-10, 19:21); Aliza Cohen, University (V-3, 18:55); Linden Bader, University (V-4, 19:22); Diana Clock, University (V-10, 19:38).

The boys saw two individual champions, with Ryan Mack of Ukiah powering to a fine D-II win (15:23) and Celedonio Rodriguez of Elsie Allen overwhelming the field in the last mile to take the D-III win (15:25). As well, top 10 finishers included Brent Shaw, Cardinal Newman (IV-5, 16:08); Sean Drake, University (V-6, 16:43); Matt Marks, Branson (V-8, 16:48); Brice Pruyn, California School for the Deaf (V-9, 16:52).

Team placings were good, with the feature team being the University girls, who cruised convincingly to their 3rd straight Division V title. The Granada girls grabbed a hard-fought 3rd in D-III. The boys' featured teams were the very consistent Redwood ins, who took a solid 3rd in D-IV, and the University boys who suprisingly took a quality 3rd in an evenly balanced D-V race.

Another mark of NCS quality is the consideration given to teams that did not make the State Meet, as evidenced by the presence of so many NCS teams in the final State Rankings. Please find a copy of those attached to this newsletter.

Coaches of the Year: These awards are purely the opinion of this publication, and are not connected in any way to anything officially NCS.

Girls: Mike McManus, University -- he has not only kept the same group of core runners at a top level, he has continued to add runners and improve the team quality to the point where they had the 3rd fastest team time at the State Meet, and the fastest team time at Mt. SAC. They ended up ranked 17th nationally by *Harrier* magazine.

Boys: Tom Lyon, Redwood -- the young team (no seniors) has a bit of a flat race at State, but were for the bulk of the season, the top NCS team and one of the best D-III teams state-wide.

The amazing North Bay League: Three State champions -- Ryan Mack, Ukiah; Celedonio Rodriguez, Elsie Allen; Sara Bei, Montgomery; (and one runner-up, Trina Cox Santa Rosa); 7 All-State Runners: Mack, Rodriguez, Bei, Cox, Jenny Aldridge of Maria Carillo, Sarah Bashel of Montgomery, Brent Shaw of Cardinal Newman. Is it the water? Secret coaching methods? Alien visitation? Genetic tampering? Whatever it is, it is good work. And then when ALL of the North Coast representatives to the Nationals (Bei,

Cox, Rodriguez) come from the same league... whew.

The almost-as-amazing Bay Counties League: Perhaps this league doesn't have total State domination, but these teams pretty much dominate D-V on the state level. The BCL put 5 teams in the final state rankings for boys' D-V: Unviersity, Branson, Lick-Wilmerding, California School for the Deaf, and Head-Royce. They also placed 7 teams in the girls' final state rankings: University, Convent, Lick-Wilmerding, Head Royce, College Prep, Branson, Contra Costa Christian. That's a deep and impressive league, on any level.

Team Times: Check out the following compilations of NCS history at the State Meet. It is interesting to see how the teams of today stack up against the teams of yesterday, and which programs consistently produce the State Meet teams.

Top Individuals: This is a list of the top NCS runners ever at the State Meet. With the State Meet staying in one spot, we have the luxury of developing a history of the race and can compare times from year to year. This is always a useful tool to get a sense of the State Meet and how to be competitive there. The cut-off times for this list were set in 1990 when I first started this list. The idea was to set a goal of a top 50 list for boys and girls, and the cut-off time was supposed to be a quality time that still allowed for yearly additions. What I have found is that the boys' times have flattened out over the last few years, so that there are fewer additions to the list. The girls side, however, has spiked considerably, with more girls running faster than I had projected. That list is well on its way to a top 100, while the boys list has yet to crest a top 40. I am going to stick with the 16:00 and 19:20 cut-off times for a year or two more, and then perhaps soften up the boys side to 16:20 to match the girls. Any thoughts on this?

More opinionated editorializing:

NCS Division I boys -- This continues to be the single sore spot for the NCS. We don't have contenders here. This year we saw Antioch and Mission, fine teams, sag at the end of the season and have lackluster performances at the State Meet. At least these teams had the potential. Previous NCS representatives to the State Meet (and my own Castro Valley team is among them) had been thin all year, and then were bottom-dwellers come race day. It is encouraging to see that we are progressing in trying to bring top teams to run in this Division, but it is discouraging to have them consistent fade at the end. We as a section can do better (and I as a coach am trying my hardest to put a representatively competitive D-1 team on the line of every race).

In all fairness, D-1 is the showcase division statewide, so that every section is promoting its best teams in D-1. As well, larger schools have larger

student populations, which means that there is a larger chance that they have talented runners. So the NCS, with only 4 true D-1 schools, has less of a chance to have D-1 schools come forward with these runners and train them. Still, given our success at every other level at the State Meet, it is pretty glaring that D-1 is our weak link.

The electronic age: Rico Balatti at De La Salle is getting some hot-shot computer kids to set up a web site for NCS track info. He says that it will be up before the season starts, and that he is looking to have as much information about NCS track as possible. So that means results: dual and invitational stats, anecdotal fabrications, coaching tips, editorial griping, whatever. This sounds like an exciting project.
