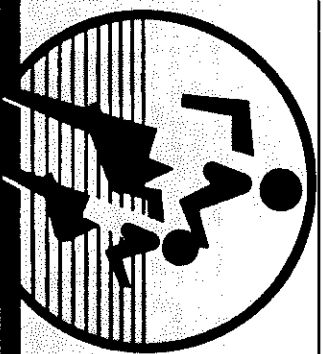

13TH ANNUAL WILLY'S ROAD RACE

PROCEEDS TO ST. FRANCIS ATHLETICS

Thank you for coming to the 13th Annual Willy's Road Race presented by St. Francis Boys' and Girls' Athletics. Taking out all the unofficial runners, we had 216 runners in the Happy Hoofers Mile, 41 in the Macho-Machette Mile and 469 in the Five Mile Race for a GRAND TOTAL of 726 runners. We were down a couple hundred runners from 1991 when we had a record crowd of 913 runners. No doubt the East West Shrine Game Run, which took place at Stanford, impacted us a little. Certainly, though, you couldn't have asked for a better day. The competition, as usual, was fast; the weather was great; the volunteers were wonderful; the prizes were great; the thrills were great; and the goodies were yummy! It all goes to prove you don't need Bay to Breaker crowds to have a good race! Why not put Willy's on your calendar for next year? IT'S ALWAYS THE 3RD SATURDAY IN JANUARY, smack dab between cross country and track season.

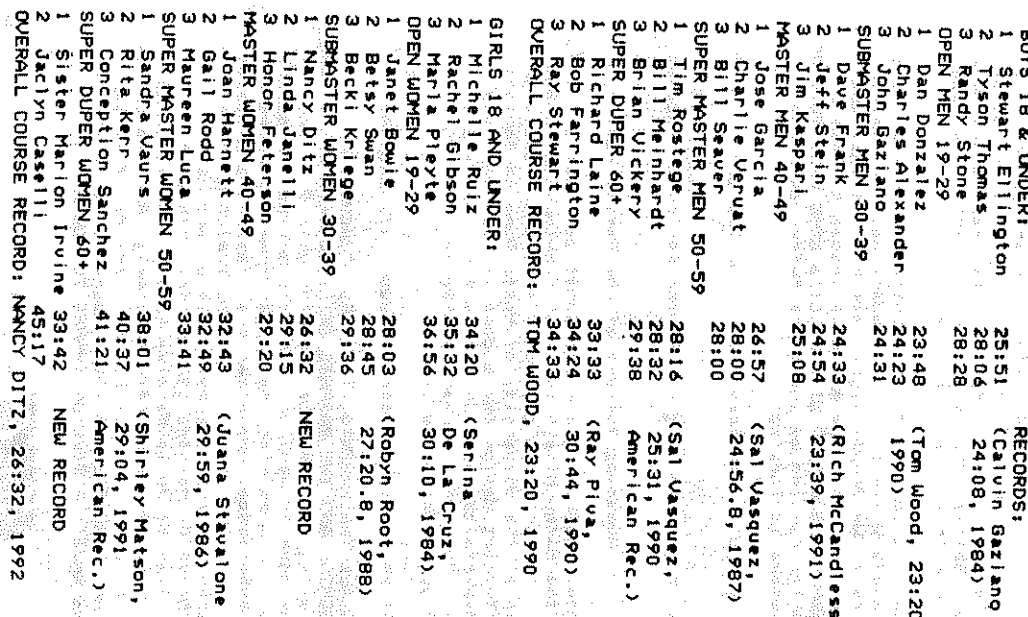

placing 2nd in 24:23 was another long time competitor, Charles Alexander. The Kinney H. S. National X-country champion and Stanford grad, has been running Willy's since 1985 and has a best of 24:05 in 1990. Although Charles has never won Willy's, he's ALWAYS in the hunt. His accomplishments as a runner are very impressive, considering he works full time for H. P. Another very familiar face but with an unfamiliar name was John (use to be "Calvin") Gaziano who placed 3rd overall in 24:31. John blew out his knee in a horrible Tai Kwon Do accident a couple years ago, but is obviously regaining top form. John was one of the top high school runners in the United States in 1980's. He ran an incredible 24:08 as a 17 year old at Willy's in 1984. That record is sure to stick around for a bit longer.

The five mill had its complement of St. Francis folks. Dave Frank, a math teacher and assistant coach for x-country at the school, placed fourth overall in 24:33. Dave had to rush off to coach a High School basketball game at St. Francis and couldn't stick around for the awards. He, like Danny Gonzalez, was very concerned, though, that he get his plate of Willy's cookies. Jim Kaspari took the honors of being the fastest St. Francis alum. Jim placed 6th in 25:08. Jim graduated from St. Francis in 1980 and has his name plastered all over the S. F. record books. As a high school senior, he ran an outstanding 15:01 on the hilly 2.9mi Crystal Springs course. Other S. F. competitors were Tyson Thomas and Randy Stone, who ran 28:06 & 28:28 (the high school division). Tyson and Randy (as it was pointed out during the awards ceremony) were key members of the St. Francis cross country team that won CCS for division III in 1991. Not only did St. Francis win CCS, they posted the fastest team time of any school in any division, and it was S. F.'s first CCS trophy! Taking the high school division at Willy's, though, was the very talented Stewart Ellington of Milpitas. He was the individual champion of the Division I CCS cross country championship at Crystal Springs in a time of 15:19 this past fall.

Among all the young folks, we had our usual high quality master contingent. Jose Garcia won the 40-49 master's division in 24:57. Tim Rostage took the 50-59 category with his 28:16 and Richard Lane found that his biggest competitor was Sister Marion Irvine! Richard ran 33:33 to Sister's 33:42. Our oldest finisher was 80 year old Joe Goodman who ran 55:03.

The women's field at Willy's was faster than ever. Nancy Ditz, age 37, broke her own course record of 26:47 set in 1987 to run 26:32. The two time winner of the Los Angeles Marathon and 1988 Seoul Olympian in the marathon, placed 19th overall and AVERAGE 5:18 per mile. Nancy couldn't hang around for the awards ceremony, as she had to go home and relieve the baby sitter. She also had to pack for the Olympic Marathon Trials in Houston where she hoped to "run fast enough to make the U. S. team". As we learned on Jan. 27, Nancy did not make the team. Yet, as she was quoted in the Times Tribune, NOT making the team could never be construed as a "sour end to her career". Nancy has enjoyed tremendous success as a runner. She'll always be an Olympian! Also, her priorities in life have changed. She is the Mom of J. R., age 2 1/2, and the trustee of Ditz-Crane, a business begun by her father. Nancy has more things than running to keep her going!

relating endo Nancy in 26:03 was 21 year old Janet Bowie, a new comer to Willy's but certainly no stranger to Bay Area running. Janet runs for Cal Berkeley and is a member of the Ryan's Sport Shop team. She is Cal's top cross country runner and (if memory serves us correctly) 5th in the Pac 10 in around 17:16 (5K at Stanford). The other college runner to place in the top ten (8th to be exact) was 22 year old Teresa Clark. The U. C. Davis Apple and St. Francis alum (class of '87) would love to be PEAKED and ready to race Willy's SOME day! Every year, though, her Mom assigns her this or that job—from leading the one millers around the course on the bike to registering runners! Nevertheless, Teresa ran 30:32 this year and has a p.r. of 29:59 on the course ('91). Teresa is coming off an excellent cross country season where she was named All American for the NCAA Div. II Championship.

On the master's scene, Joan Hannett won the 40-49 division with a 32:43 and Sandra Vauris won the 50-59 division in 38:01. Most surprising to everyone was the appearance of Sister Marion Irvine. The 62 year old Dominican nun from Napa just showed up. (Of course, that is not an unusual occurrence at Willy's. Great runners always show up and never tell the race directors that they are coming.) Anyway, we suppose Sister couldn't stand NOT having her name in the Willy's record book. She had the 50-59 record of 30:46 (posted in '88) until it was broken by Shirley Watson in '91. NOW she has the 60+ record with her time of 33:42, eclipsing Jackie Caselli's record of 37:25. (Many of you, no doubt, saw what happened on the stage when Jackie complained about her record being broken! Sister Marion Irvine tried to stick her face -- a potted plant from JUST FOR YOU FLORIST -- in front of Jackie's face before the photographer took the picture! Ladies, ladies, ladies. . . . PLEASE!) Actually, we think they were teasing each other!

Some other notable finishers in the race included Michelle Ruiz who OFFICIALLY entered the 18 & under division and won it in 34:20. (See Macho Michelle Mile for the scoop on Michelle!) Also, Sandy Sup (always a top finisher at Willy's) RAN FOR TWO! Sandy, who is seven months pregnant, jogged through Willy's in 45:28. That's just a tad slower than her 29:07 in 1989.

HAPPY HOOFER MILE

Many familiar faces were at this year's edition of the Willy's Road Race. To name but a few, we saw the Mindigos, the Rattis, the Zanders, the Simons, the Garcias of Gilroy and the Castillas family compete. Yet, it was a set of newcomers who took the victory in the Happy Hooper Mile. Thirteen year old Beebe Rutledge and his 12 year old sister, Andrea Rutledge, of the Woodside Striders placed 1st and 2nd overall in the 222 member field. They had times of 5:09 and 6:02 respectively. Beebe's time was a mere six seconds off the divisional course record for 11-13 year old boys set by Jason Carroll in 1983 (5:03).

Other notable performances involved the Pitts family from Santa Clara. Mom, Dad and all four children ran in the Happy Hooper race! Three of the children placed in various age group divisions. Little Rachel Pitts, age 7, wiped out a long time girls' seven and under record by running a very quick 6:49. She bested Stephanie Quay's 1986 time of 7:20 by 31 seconds and was 20th place overall.

St. Joseph School competitors made their mark. Ben Buck won the 7 and under boys division with a time of 7:35 and eight year old Stephan Barry ran a school record of 6:51. Both boys make Willy's Road Race their "once a year" race, but as their P. E. teacher (Ellen Clark) can attest, they are like speeding bullets on the playing fields at school.

MACHO/MACHETTE MILE

The Macho Machette mile was really fun to watch this year. Within the 43 member field, we didn't have any course records, but it hardly mattered. To see college, high school and master runners slug it out was good entertainment. Rick Reitz captured the mile in 4:31, but didn't have the race in the bag until the final 100 meters. His 4:31 was the 5th fastest Macho Mile and nine seconds off Stephen Schadler's 4:20.1. Pushing Rick all the way to the finish was Andy Bupp, a long time Willy's competitor who runs for Cal. Andy was a tremendous cross country runner in high school. In 1988, he was undefeated in the Central Coast Section and was, of course, the CCS cross country champion. In 3rd place was new comer to Willy's, Don Strong. Don runs cross country and track for Hayward State and has another interesting hobby--sliding down mountains at supersonic speeds. It's called "tuging". Don took time out from running to train at Lake Placid. After not making the Olympic team in the June, he decided to return to distance running. Don says he's now trying to keep his weight down and get his "running legs" back.

Dunking it out over the course were the high school and master runners. It's interesting to note that wherever there was a high school runner, it's runner was not on the teen-ager's heels. Senior Tyson Thomas (age 18) of St. Francis High School had all he could handle with 45 year old Jim Hampton of West Valley Track Club. Running neck and neck most of the way, Tyson put in a little kick on the final stretch to run 4:41 and win the high school division. Jim cruised in at 4:43, an excellent time for a master runner on the Willy's course. Too bad we don't have a master's division for the Macho race. (We'll have to think about that!)

One interesting match up was between 48 year old Bill Clark (co-race director for Willy's) and 47 year old Ed Dean. Both gentlemen were teammates on the University of Notre Dame track team in the early 60's. Ed would have preferred that a certain race director NOT mention he ran a 4:01 in college to the crowd! He'd like to get back into master's mile shape in relative anonymity. Nevertheless, Ed hung with Bill until the half-way mark. Then, with Bill's joints well lubricated, he kicked it in for a POST KNEE operation personal record of 5:21. Sophomore Henry Darious and Freshman Phil Stefani, two very talented cross country runners from St. Francis, were passed by "Mr. Clark" and left to battle it out. Both posted excellent times of 5:31 and 5:32.

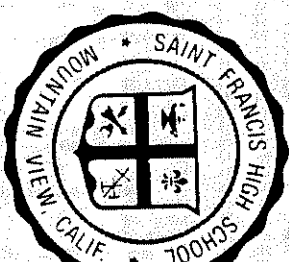
For some reason, only six females entered the Macho Machette Mile. One young lady SHOULD have OFFICIALLY entered the mile because she could have been a double winner at Willy's. Instead this person (hint '91 St. Francis valedictorian and Stanford freshman) ran through the finish line and left the victory to Maria Pleyte who ran 5:36. Fourteen year old Maria was followed
