- 1968: Region II playoffs at Foothill, 3-8
Fremont (Sunnyvale, SCVAL) 60, Palo Alto 49
Fremont in control after outscoring Paly 21-8 in second quarter.
Fremont eventually won tournament.
- 1969 Region II playoffs at CSM, 2-28
Buchser (Santa Clara, SCVAL) 65, Ravenswood 54
Buchser built up early lead, then withstood David Hill and
Richard Young led Trojan rally in fourth quarter.
Willow Glen eventually won CCS crown by beating Santa Cruz
for title and undefeated 27-0 season. Santa Cruz had
beaten Buchser, which then beat Riordan for third place.
- 1970 Region II playoffs at Foothill, 2-27
Buchser 67, Woodside 46
Buchser in command whole way against Woodside, which didn't
get the ball to 7-0 junior center Rich Kelley.
Buchser won the whole thing, beating Alisal in finals.
- 1971 Region II playoffs at Canada, 2-26
Fremont 57, Woodside 43
Fremont's better overall team play beats Woodside and 7-0
center Rich Kelley.
Alisal went on to beat Mitty in CCS finals while Fremont
lost both games in the tourney and finished fourth.
